About the Project

Merrill Gardens at Rolling Hills Estates is a 134,985 square foot senior living project located on the corner of Silver Spur Road and Dry Bank Drive. The community includes 94 independent/assisted living units, 20 memory care units, 18,175 square feet of common amenity space, 16,965 square feet of common outdoor landscaped courtyards and parking for 64 vehicles in a partially below grade garage.

This past month has seen a lot of upward progress on the Merrill Gardens at Rolling Hills project. We now have all of the wall framing standing through the third floor across half of the Silver Spur frontage. The month of March will see roof trusses and roofing installed as well as more concrete deck pours moving closer to Dry Bank Drive. After that, we will see the start of exterior insulation and window installation.
